


Screen Options

These screens are designed to keep insects outside, while letting natural light inside. Choose a Bottom Rolling Extruded Screen, a Heavy Duty Bottom Rolling Extruded Screen, or a Top Hanging Screen.

If you prefer not to have a screen, that is an option also.

Tempered Glass^{*}


This type of glass is treated with heat so it can withstand greater force or pressure on its surface, and it will not break into sharp pieces. This is mostly used on patio doors or windows that are installed near floor level.

Sidelites & Transoms

Our sliding patio door can be combined with sidelites and transoms to make the best use of your door opening, allowing more natural light to enter your home and giving your patio door unique style. Sidelites are available in 2'6" to 4'0" widths. Our Siteline transom option features sashed transoms to create even vertical sight lines.









Blinds Between the Glass (BBG)

Blinds Between the Glass (BBG) provide privacy and are virtually maintenance-free. The blinds, which have no exposed cords, are thermally sealed between clear insulating glass; so there's no need for dusting. They're also easy to raise, lower and tilt with a reduced travel operator that moves the blinds two inches for every one inch you move. Additional benefits include less exposure to allergens, reduced fading of interior furnishings, and increased energy efficiency.


